

# REPAIRS HAPPEN. THE BILL DOESN'T HAVE TO.

Our Labor Warranty covers what other warranties don't, so a service call never turns into a budget event.

The average HVAC repair in 2026 runs **between \$450 and \$650 per visit**, and that number's climbing every year. A compressor replacement averages **\$1,200 to \$2,500 in labor alone**. Refrigerant has gotten brutal since the 2025 phase-down and now runs **\$75 to \$200 a pound**. Most factory warranties cover parts only. Ours covers everything that touches the repair.

### WHAT REPAIRS COST WITHOUT IT

*Why this warranty pays for itself.*

What homeowners are actually paying in 2026 when a repair lands outside of warranty coverage.

#### 2026 INDUSTRY AVERAGES

- ▶ Average repair visit: **\$450 to \$650**
- ▶ Compressor replacement: **\$1,200 to \$2,500** (labor only)
- ▶ Refrigerant: **\$75-\$200/lb** (most systems hold 6-8 lbs)
- ▶ Trip and diagnostic fee: **\$70 to \$200**, more after hours
- ▶ Emergency/after-hours surcharge: **\$150 to \$400 extra** per call

**The math:** One avoided compressor repair covers the entire warranty cost. One refrigerant leak repair covers half of it. Most homeowners hit at least one of those inside a 5-year window. The warranty's already paid for itself.

## WHY YEARLY MAINTENANCE IS REQUIRED

### IT'S NOT A CATCH. IT'S HOW BOTH WARRANTIES STAY ACTIVE.

Two reasons. **One**, your equipment manufacturer requires yearly maintenance to honor their parts warranty, so we're keeping you covered on both sides. **Two**, maintained systems last 5 to 7 years longer and run about 25% more efficient (U.S. Department of Energy). Yearly maintenance reduces emergency breakdowns by up to 95%. We'd recommend it anyway. We're just making sure it actually gets done.
